

Position Questionnaire

The purpose of this questionnaire is to confirm agreement between board candidates and Daystar Baptist Missions' stance on a few positions that fall outside the realm of core doctrinal agreement. This is not meant to trick you, challenge you, or be judgmental in anyway. 1. Translations: We do not seek for this to be a contentious issue as we consider it a personal and/or individual ministry preference. We recognize not all translations carry equal value, but we do not mandate one version for our missionaries. We allow for each missionary's sending church to guide in this issue for their missionary.
